4. TO DISCUSS THE FOLLOWING PLANNING APLICATIONS AND TO AGREE ACTION IN RESPONSE TO PROPOSALS:

Two more applications had been received which needed to be dealt with prior to the next meeting. All agreed to receive.

a. NP/24/0332/FUL – Extend an already existing drop kerb by four flats and one right hand riser, widening of driveway entrance and additional works to front boundary wall – Drinagh, Serpentine Road, Tenby

Councillors discussed the application, one commenting that they were a big fan as it takes vehicles off road. All were in favour.

RECOMMEND

Approval. The application site is within a section of carriageway where this proposal will not adversely impact on-street parking provision to any great extent.

b. NP/24/0414/FUL - Proposed first floor bedroom extension to existing dwelling - Bronwen, 1 Edward Street, Tenby

Councillors discussed and viewed the application. All in favour.

RECOMMEND

Approval. The proposal will not have an adverse effect on the amenity of neighbouring properties.

c. NP/24/0424/TPO - Works required to TPO 68 (T2 Sycamore) to reduce overall crown volume through crown reduction, reshaping and lifting; to create maintain a feature tree, which reduces excessive shading to adjoining property and mitigates future risk of fall hazard. d. NP/24/0422/S73 - Variation of condition 2, and removal of conditions 4, 5, 6, 7, and 8 of NP/23/0632/FUL - Alterations & extension to detached single storey dwelling & removal of chimney - Longshaw, North Cliffe, Tenby, Pembrokeshire, SA70 8AT
