Tenby Community Fridge

This is based in the Old Chapel on Lower Frog St and aims to help reduce food waste by collecting food from local supermarkets and taking it to the Fridge so that we can all pop down to see if there is something that we can use, to save it going into landfill. It is open Tuesdays to Saturdays 11 to 3pm.

This is only possible because of the great volunteers who help to keep it going. People are needed to open the fridge and check the temperature in the mornings, make sure it is tidy when it closes in the afternoon, and of course, to fetch the food from the supermarkets in the evenings.
