In the afternoon a variety of activities take place, such as a healthy eating workshop, a qi gong session, seated yoga, painting and sculpture. Everyone is welcome!

### Tenby Portrait Group

This group meets on **Monday mornings** at 10am in Greenhill Community Learning Centre and needs sitters to get their portraits done. This involves choosing a position and staying still for two lots of 45 minutes while the group members draw you, with a break for a cup of tea in between.

### Tenby Flea Market

This takes place **every Tuesday** in the De Valence Pavilion from 10am to 4pm. There are always several stalls, and it is worth a look as you never know what you might find there!

### Tenby and Saundersfoot Chess Club

### Life Skills Classes
