Films4Tenby present 'Sorry, Baby'

On **Tuesday 8th September**, Films4Tenby is screening 'Sorry, Baby'. The film follows a reclusive college professor struggling with depression and her best friend's pregnancy following a serious traumatic assault. It won the Screenwriting Award at the Sundance Film Festival and Best Directorial Debut from the National Board of Review and actress/writer/director Eve Victor was also nominated for Best Actress at the Golden Globes. The doors will open at 6.30 with the film starting at 7pm, entrance is £5 or £4 if you are a member of Films4Tenby. You can book a 2-course pre-screening meal for £13 at the Fuschia café.

Thursday 24th – **Tenby Male Choir** end of season gala concert at St Mary's Church. For their final celebratory concert of the Summer Season, they will be joined by the Paul Sartori Community Choir and our President Wynne Evans BEM. Doors from 18.30 for a 7.30pm start.

Friday 25th – The world premiere of '**The Mask Slips**', a murder mystery staged radio play written by Mark Lewis, at 7pm at St Mary's Church House, £5 entrance

Saturday 26th – a **Community Fun Day** in St Mary's Church House and grounds between 11 and 3pm, including a **skill sharing session** where you can drop in for 10-minute skill stations where

you can learn quick life hacks, simple crafts, upcycling tips, and play outdoor lawn games. There will also be the unveiling of '**Tenby Ship of Dreams**' a project that connects Tenby's maritime identity with the historic voyage of the *HMT Empire Windrush* with a model of a Tenby Lugger built by local artist, Sam Hutchinson and a collection of community hopes and dreams on the sails collected by Glyn Harries. The Ship is being paraded up from Tenby Harbour to Church House at 12pm. You will be able to add your hopes and dreams on the day.

There will also be a **Bring and Share Feast** between 12.30 and 2pm. Tenby Town Council is producing a recipe book with contributions from people living in Tenby and the surrounding areas which could be recipes from their roots or heritage or recipes passed down in their family, along with a comment to go with it about why the recipe is important to them. Saturday 26th - followed by '**Blues Echoes**', songs and stories about the blues with Phil Okwedy and "the search for liberation, the fight for justice and the reasons why we still need the blues" in St Mary's Church House at 7pm, £5 entry.
